

Back to School Mask Portraits

Celebrate YOU before heading off to school with this fun 5 step *Mask Portrait Craft*. All you need is a piece of paper, a pencil and what ever coloring materials you have on hand. That can be crayons, markers or colored pencils !!

Let's get crafty:

1. Fold your paper in half, and then fold that half in half. When you unfold your paper you should have 4 sections.
2. Draw yourself in the first 2 sections, make sure your head takes up most of that space.
3. (Don't forget to add your name in cool bubble letters in that 3rd section. That's what I did!)
4. Next fold your paper in half, covering your face, and then fold down one panel so your eyes peek out!
5. Draw the bottom half of your face again — Including the super-cool-fancy face mask you're going to rock on your first day!!

Don't forget to hang it somewhere to remind you to stay safe and have an awesome day at school every morning.
