







## Black History Month STEAM Craft :

### Draw a Comic on How a Vaccine Work

**Vaccine (noun):** A medical preparation used to provide immunity to a specific infectious disease. The medicine is usually made of a harmless or weaker form of the disease. The treatment is usually provided by a doctor, nurse or other healthcare worker via injection or oral medication.

**Drawing Instructions:** Here are some sample captions that explain how a vaccine works. Use your imagination and draw the vaccine and healing action.

 <p data-bbox="89 1694 760 1782">The immune system will remember how to make antibodies to protect the patient's body.</p>	 <p data-bbox="787 1694 1502 1782">If the disease returns, antibodies will attack the virus.</p>
